## A HOARD OF DENARII AND ANTONINIANI FROM THE VILLAGE OF GLIBOVAC NEAR SMEDEREVSKA PALANKA\*

**Abstract:** The Glibovac hoard was discovered in the eponymous village in the Bubanja area near Smederevska Palanka. In 1919, 375 pieces were purchased for the National Museum of Serbia. After the conservation treatment and review, it was established that the hoard contained 339 denarii and antoniniani, spanning the period from Septimius Severus (195 AD) to Trebonianus Gallus and Volusian (252/253).

**Key words:** Roman Empire, coin hoards, Trebonianus Gallus, Glibovac, Moesia Superior.

The hoard of denarii and antoniniani was discovered in the vicinity of Smederevska Palanka, in the Bubanja area of the village of Glibovac.<sup>1</sup> It was purchased in April 1919 for the Art and History Museum (National Museum of Serbia) and consisted of 375 denarii and antoniniani, spanning the period from Septimius Severus to Trebonianus Gallus and Volusian (Table 2).<sup>2</sup> The hoard was initially processed and published by Jožo

Petrović in 1930, who stated that a total of 375 Roman coins were purchased, but went on to say: “Described here are 339 pieces and we were unable to save 36 pieces that have been ruined by rust”<sup>3</sup> As the hoard was published according to the standards and known literature of that time (Cohen), we deemed it necessary to perform a revision in keeping with the new reference literature.<sup>4</sup>

The village of Glibovac is located approximately four kilometres west of Smederevska Palanka, on the route to Mladenovac. While publishing the Mezul I hoard, the authors of this paper worked on developing the thesis of M. Vasić about the presumed course of the vicinal road from *Vinceia* (Smederevo), by way of the present-day Vlaški Do, to Smederevska Palanka and on to the south. On the basis of unpublished documentation from reconnoitring by the National Museum from Smederevska Palanka, the authors proposed that two more vicinal routes led from Smederevska Palanka, approximately along the routes of present-day roads: towards the north-west by way of Glibovac, Kusatak, Rabrovac to Mt. Kosmaj; towards the south-west via Cerovac, Bašin, Kloka to Mt. Rudnik.<sup>5</sup> Reconnoitring in Glibovac, in the Bubanja area where the coin hoard was discovered, was performed in 1972 and no remains from the Roman period were registered, but many fragments of Roman ceramics were found to the east of this slope, in the valley.<sup>6</sup>

The hoard from Glibovac belongs to the horizon of hoards deposited in the time of Trebonianus Gallus and Volusian, which can be divided into the categories deposited at the end of 251 and in 252/253 and, within that frame, into hoards of silver or bronze provincial coins.<sup>7</sup> For a better insight, we have classified the hoards according to the mentioned criteria in the following table:

Among the hoards that contain denarii and antoniniani, the original composition of two have largely been compromised (Ćićevac and Unknown site 2), which

allows for the possibility that they were deposited at a somewhat later time.<sup>8</sup> The preserved parts of these hoards end with the following specimens: Čičevac – IMP CAE C VIB TREB GALLVS AVG / LIBERALITAS AVGG (RIC IV/3, No. 37); Unknown site 2 – IMP CAE C VIB VOLVSIANO AVG / VIRTVS AVGG (RIC IV/3, No. 186); the antoninianus of Trebonianus Gallus from the incomplete Čičevac hoard, of the Rome mint, has been classified according to RIC as the 2<sup>nd</sup> issue and dated to the end of 251, while M. Vasić classified it as issue IIa and dated it to the same year.<sup>9</sup> The ultimately preserved antoninianus of Volusian from the Unknown site 2 hoard is classified according to RIC as the 3<sup>rd</sup> issue and dated to the autumn of 251,<sup>10</sup> while, according to M. Vasić, it belongs to issue IIa from the end of 251. The preserved parts of these hoards are characterized by compromised integrity and are insufficiently documented, so they certainly fall in the category of insufficiently reliable historical sources. Viewed in this context, the preserved parts of the mentioned hoards can only serve as a contribution to information about coins in circulation in the territory of Moesia Superior in the middle of the 3<sup>rd</sup> century.

The only one of the analogous hoards containing silver coins and is assumed to have been almost completely preserved is the hoard named “Serbia, unknown site”. According to the published records of B. Saria from 1924 and 1925, it was discovered in the National Museum after the massive losses that the numismatic collection suffered during World War I, but it was impossible already at that time to establish where and when the hoard was found. Saria believed that it arrived in the Museum in its entirety after 1905. It contained 1,324 denarii and antoniniani from Caracalla to Trebonianus Gallus and Volusian, which Saria published.<sup>11</sup> Nowadays, 1,287 denarii and antoniniani are kept in the National Museum of Serbia, among which 61 specimens from the Consecratio Issue. The most recent specimens in this hoard belong to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> issue of the Viminacium mint, dated in 251-253 AD: Trebonianus Gallus (RIC IV/3, No. 69, 70 – Issue 1; RIC IV/3, No. 71, 72 – Issue 2), Volusian (RIC IV/3, No. 206 – Issue 1; RIC IV/3, No. 205 – Issue 2).<sup>12</sup> As for the analogous hoards that contain only bronze provincial coins of the Viminacium and Dacia mints (Table 1), they are dated to 252 (Bošnjane in the vicinity of Vranje) or 252/253 AD (Vrkašica, Brežane, vicinity of Jagodina, Izvore).<sup>13</sup>

The hoard from Glibovac contains 339 specimens of Roman silver coins – 36 denarii (10.62%) and 303 (89.38%) antoniniani, spanning the period from Septimius Severus (195 AD) to Trebonianus Gallus and Volusian (252/253) and it has the following composition:

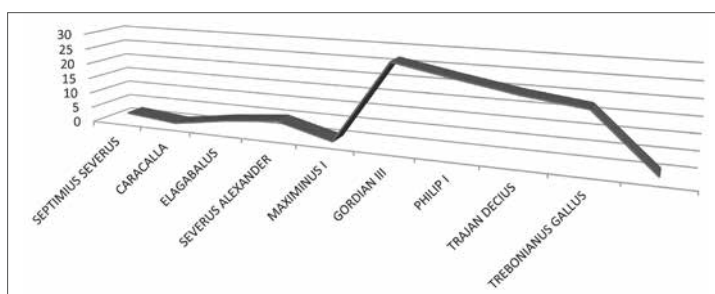

By condensing the number of specimens within the time frame of the reign of individual emperors and family members, we obtained the following composition percentages in the hoard (Table 3; Graph 1):

In the analysis of the years/months of the reign of emperors and the attributed specimens of family members, with the frequency (number of coin specimens) in the hoard, the following annual quotients and percentages are obtained:<sup>14</sup>

The Glibovac hoard contains coins of 18 rulers and their family members from the period of 58 years (Tables 2, 3). The biggest percentage is that of the issues of Gordian III (26.84%), followed by the coinage of Philip I (23.30%) and Trajan Decius (20.05%). The most recent issues of Trebonianus Gallus and Volusian are present in an exceptionally high percentage (17.69%), unlike the usual final issues in the mid-3<sup>rd</sup> century hoards.<sup>16</sup> The older issues in the hoard from Glibovac, from Septimius Severus to Maximinus I, range between 0.30% and 5.1% and lead to the conclusion that they represent the remains of an older deposit (Table 3, Graph 1). Viewed by annual inflow (Table 4), the highest percentages are registered in the same period, albeit in different order. A particularly high annual inflow, considering the short period of reign, were registered for the issues of Trajan Decius (38.13%), followed by the most recent issues of Trebonianus Gallus (27.26%), while the issues of Gordian III and Philip are present in somewhat lower percentages (15.78% and 13.70%). The analysis shows that intensive thesauration began with the coins of Gordian III and continued with almost the same intensity until the final issues of Trebonianus Gallus and Volusian, when it suddenly stopped.

Coins of the Rome mint are present in the highest percentage in the Glibovac hoard (93.10%), followed by the Viminacium mint with a significant 19.59%, while the Milan mint is present with only one specimen (0.30%). Eastern mints are represented with 6.90%, the highest percentage of which belong to the Antioch mint (5.93%) (Table 5). The sole specimen of the Emesa mint was registered among the issues of Septimius Severus, after which only the issues of the Antioch mint are present, registered among the coins of Severus Alexander (2), Gordian III (10), Philip I (6) and Trebonianus Gallus (2).

The issues of **Septimius Severus** and family are among the earliest specimens in the Glibovac hoard, distributed in six issues of the Rome mint from 197 to 202. Also present is one denarius of the Emesa mint (Cat. 5), struck for Severus himself in 195 AD. One denarius belongs to the period of the joint reign of Caracalla and Geta from 211 (Cat. 9), whereas only one denarius of Iulia Domna, from the 8<sup>th</sup> issue of the Rome mint, struck in 216, belongs to **Caracalla's** individual issues. The distribution of issues of Septimius Severus and family and Caracalla's individual coinage is given in the following table (Table 6):<sup>17</sup>

Following are the issues of **Elagabalus** (11 pieces) which, besides specimens struck for the emperor himself (Cat. 11-18), also include issues for Iulia Maesa (Cat. 19-21). All the coins from the period of Elagabalus' reign were issued by the Rome mint. Besides denarii, four antoniniani were registered, struck for the issuer himself (Cat. 13, 15, 17) and one for Iulia Maesa (Cat. 19). An overview of the representation of all these issues, according to the year of minting, is given in the following table (Table 7).

The coinage of **Severus Alexander** and **Iulia Mamaea** (17 denarii, Cat. 22-38) is present in slightly greater numbers, of which two denarii belong to issues of the Antioch mint (Cat. 34-35) and the rest to the Rome mint. The few specimens of coins of Severus Alexander in the Glibovac hoard do not provide the possibility for a more detailed analysis of the representation of particular issues (Table 8).

The coinage of **Maximinus I** is represented in the Glibovac hoard with only one denarius (Cat. 39), belonging to the 1<sup>st</sup> issue, dated in 235.

Following are the most numerous issues of **Gordian III** (91), 81 of which belong to issues of the Rome mint (Cat. 40-120) and 10 to those of the Antioch mint (Cat. 121-130). The ratio of specimens of Rome and Antioch show a prominent prevalence of the Rome mint – 89% to 11%. Among the coins in the Glibovac hoard that preceded those of Gordian III, we registered the already mentioned four antoniniani of Elagabalus and Iulia Maesa though, ordinarily, from Gordian III onwards, antoniniani dominated over the denarii (89 to 2).<sup>18</sup> A larger number of specimens allows for classification by issues and officinae (Table 9).<sup>19</sup>

Emissions of issue 4 are by far the most numerous, which is expected due to its being the central ruler's issue. This is the general rule, confirmed by the analyses of other Moesian hoards. The fourth emission of the Rome mint, as observed earlier, represents the biggest, central issue of Gordian's rule, which was marked by a new policy, created and directed by the praetorian prefect Timisitheus.<sup>20</sup> Similar ratios in the representation of issues can be observed in the Glibovac hoard, with a constant increase in the inflow of coins from 238 to 243 and an abrupt drop in the ruler's last year to the levels of issues from the start of his reign.

Issues of Philip I and family are represented in the Glibovac hoard with 79 antoniniani (Cat. 131-209), 56 of which belong to the ruler, 8 to Otacilia Severa (Cat 187-194) and 15 to Philip II (Cat. 195-209). Sixty eight issues of the Rome mint distributed among all members of the family have been registered. Six antoniniani of the Antioch mint are present only with Otacilia Severa and Philip II, whereas issues of the Viminacium mint are only present among coins of Philip I.<sup>21</sup> According to Eddy, one antoninianus (Cat. 186) is classified as issue 3 of the Milan mint, while it is attributed to the Rome mint according to RIC IV/3, as well as according to Vasić from 2005, coupled with the fact that it was additionally classified as issue 8.<sup>22</sup> The distribution of issues is provided in Table 10:<sup>23</sup>

One can see that the biggest number of issues by far (32) belong to issue 3 (245-247), while the presence of issues of 248-249 is very small (Table 10). This phenomenon has already been explained by M. Vasić, who pointed out that the absence of the Rome mint's issues from 249 in the Donje Crniljevo hoard could be explained with the rebellion and usurpation by Pacatian in Moesia Superior and Pannonia Inferior, which caused a slower inflow of coins from Rome.<sup>24</sup> It was observed that only specimens minted for Otacilia Severa and Philip II belong to officina 2, issues 2 and 3 of the Rome mint, while officinae 1 and 3 are only found among specimens of Philip I.

The long standing opinion is that a secondary imperial mint opened in Viminacium during the reign of Philip I.<sup>25</sup> Presented here is an overview of known coin hoards from the present-day territory of Serbia<sup>26</sup> that contain specimens of issue 1 of the Viminacium mint from 246-267 of Philip I (RIC IV/3, No. 51) and/or issue 2 of Philip II (RIC IV/3, No. 226) that is linked to the end of 248-249:<sup>27</sup>

The following most numerous issues in the Glibovac hoard are those for Trajan Decius and family (Cat. 201-277), represented in our find with 68 antoniniani, 47 (69.10%) of which belong to the Rome mint and 21 (30.90%) to that in Viminacium (Table 12).

One can observe that, in the hoards that lack specimens from Antioch, three of them (Glibovac, Supska I and Sikirica III) have a higher than usual inflow of the Viminacium mint in relation to the Mint of Rome (Table 13). In the other two (the Belgrade find and Vlajića Brdo I) we have registered the inflow of the Rome mint to be higher than 80%.<sup>28</sup> On the basis of the currently available knowledge, the hoard from Glibovac shows the highest frequency of the Viminacium mint in relation to that of Rome, because specimens of Herennia Etruscilla RIC IV/3 No. 58 and 59

have been excluded from the calculation, so precise data can only be obtained after a revision of the hoards.<sup>29</sup>

Besides the issues for Trajan Decius himself of the Viminacium mint (Cat. 239-241), issues for members of the imperial family were also registered: Herennia Etruscilla (Cat. 259-262), Herennius Etruscus (Cat. 265-275) and three consecration antoniniani, minted for Trajan, Marcus Aurelius and Severus Alexander (Cat. 242-244).<sup>30</sup>

The final issues in the hoard belong to Trebonianus Gallus and Volusian, with a total of 60 antoniniani (Cat. 278-337), of which 41 for the issuer (Cat. 278-318) and 19 for Volusian (Cat. 319-337). The ratio of frequencies of the Rome and Viminacium mints is exceptionally large in favour of the latter (26.70% to 70%), while the Antioch mint's presence is far lesser (93.30%). A comparison of the proportion of these three mints in analogous hoards does not provide data for reaching accurate conclusions because of extremely large variations between them (Table 14). The only find to have been preserved in entirety is the Belgrade Find (Cara Uroša Street) and we could expect that the ratio of mints in that example can serve as the correct starting point, especially due to the hoard having an exceptionally high percentage of Viminacium issues compared with other hoards. Unfortunately, 13% of the find (365 pieces) were seriously damaged and adhered to the inside of the lead vessel's lid.<sup>31</sup> That is why we cannot exclude the possibility that specimens of Trebonianus Gallus and Volusian could be among the unidentified pieces. For this reason, the presented results (Table 14) should be taken with a measure of reserve.

By analysing how many coins each of the three mints issued for Trebonianus Gallus and Volusian, on the example of the Glibovac hoard (Table 15), we can confirm the conclusion of M. Vasić from 2005. While studying the Donje Crniljevo hoard, Vasić concluded that the Rome mint issued approximately an equal number of coins for the two co-rulers, while the Viminacium and Antioch mints made incomparably more coins for Gallus.<sup>32</sup>

It can be observed that the Glibovac hoard lacks the specimens of the 1<sup>st</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> issue of the Rome mint and of the 2<sup>nd</sup> issue of the Antioch mint. The 4<sup>th</sup> issue of the Rome mint was dated in 253 AD, and we know that Aemilianus' usurpation began most probably in the middle of the year.<sup>33</sup> The most recent and only specimen of the

On the other hand, we are faced with the problem of it not being possible to precisely date the issues from the Viminacium and Antioch mints, and the only thing that can be stated is that issues of the Viminacium mint from 251-253 participated in the Glibovac find in a significant percentage (issue 1 with 31 pieces and issue 2 with 11 pieces). The Antioch mint is present with two antoniniani struck for Trebonianus Gallus (Table 15). On the basis of all the above stated, we believe that the *terminus post quem* of the Glibovac hoard should be sought in the first half of 253 AD, i.e. just before the start of Aemilianus' usurpation at the end of June in that same year.<sup>34</sup>

What testifies about the tumultuous times in the Balkans in the middle of the 3<sup>rd</sup> century are numerous coin hoards deposited in Moesia Superior and neighbouring provinces in this period. Seven hoards deposited during the reign of Trajan Decius have been registered in Moesia Superior so far,<sup>35</sup> with reasons for depositing stemming from the turbulent internal events from the end of the reign of Philip I and during Pacatian's usurpation.<sup>36</sup> Of these seven hoards, one was discovered in the south of the province (Klisurica), one in the north (Mezul I), while the rest are linked with its eastern part (present-day western Bulgaria). The hoard from Sirmium is one of the three known hoards from the territory of Pannonia Inferior,<sup>37</sup> no whole hoards from this period have been found in Pannonia Superior.<sup>38</sup> It is known that Trajan Decius resided in the Balkans during the two years of his reign and fought the barbarians in Moesia Inferior, Thrace and Dacia.<sup>39</sup> This undoubtedly left a trace in coin finds in the neighbouring Dacia (8),<sup>40</sup> and in the particularly numerous ones from Moesia Inferior (73) and Thrace (27).<sup>41</sup> Generally, the period from 248 to 254 AD was continuously beleaguered by turbulent internal and external events, especially in provinces along the lower course of the Danube.<sup>42</sup> The exceptionally high number of coin hoards from this period is certainly connected with this. However, it is often not possible to singularly connect them with a particular

barbarian raid, or even with a particular reign on the basis of their *terminus post quem*, for several reasons. The first is that a large number of known hoards from this period cannot be taken as reliable historic sources due to the conditions of their discovery and to it not being known if they were preserved in entirety. Besides, constant pressure from the barbarians during a succession of briefly reigning emperors opens the possibility for the assumption that, for instance, hoards that end with specimens of Philip I from 247-249 AD could have been deposited during the reign of Trajan Decius, and suchlike.<sup>43</sup>

Contrary to the period of the reign of Philip I and Trajan Decius, the percentage ratios of hoards from Moesia Superior on the one side, and Dacia, Moesia Inferior and Thrace on the other, significantly changed in the period from 251 to 253 AD. A total of 17 hoards were deposited in Moesia Superior in the time of Trebonianus Gallus and Aemilianus (13 – *tpq.* Trebonianus Gallus and 4 – *tpq.* Aemilianus),<sup>44</sup> five in Pannonia Inferior,<sup>45</sup> while their number in Moesia Inferior is 18 (of which two – *tpq.* Aemilianus)<sup>46</sup> and all in Dacia (6) are from the time of Trebonianus Gallus.<sup>47</sup> There is an obvious greater presence of hoards in Moesia Superior than in the previous period, in relation to the neighbouring provinces. The majority of these hoards are concentrated along the valley of the Velika Morava and Južna Morava rivers, except for the hoard from the village of Izvore near Kosovska Mitrovica and four hoards from the east of the province, in present-day Bulgaria.

After the defeat and demise of Decius, the Balkan provinces were exposed over an extended period to constant attack by Goths and their allies. Neither Trebonianus Gallus, nor Aemilianus were able to push them back across the Danube.<sup>48</sup> In addition to that, the situation was additionally aggravated by the great plague epidemic that spread throughout the entire Empire in 252-253 AD.<sup>49</sup> Sources also mention the intensive persecution of Christians, from the time of Decius all the way to the death of Valerian I.<sup>50</sup> The reasons for the depositing of so many coin hoards in Moesia Superior remain in the sphere of assumptions because it is not possible to arguably connect their concealment with some of the events that were general or local in character.<sup>51</sup>

## CATALOGUE

### INTRODUCTORY NOTES

The catalogue is arranged chronologically according to the reigns of the Roman emperors, and in the context of individual emperors, by mints and dates of minting. Each catalogue number includes the obverse and reverse legends and images, and contains the standard basic data, arranged according to the following criteria: the catalogue numbers referring to the individual reigning emperor, and the members of imperial family, living or deified; technical data about the coin (weight), the citation according to the standard literature together with notes on coin, the minting year, and the inventory number (The National Museum of Serbia collection). The notes contain additional informations on coins and indicating possible aberrations from examples documented in the standard literature. The date of minting of coins follows the chronology based on the relevant cited literature. All the coins are presented in photographic form, and their numeration on the plates is coordinated with the catalogue numbers.

## ОСТАВА ДЕНАРА И АНТОНИНИЈАНА ИЗ СЕЛА ГЛИБОВАЦ КОД СМЕДЕРЕВСКЕ ПАЛАНКЕ

### РЕЗИМЕ

Остава денара и антонинијана нађена је у близини Смедеревске Паланке, на путу Бубања, у селу Глибовац. За тадашњи Уметничко-историјски музеј (Народни музеј Србије) окупљена је у априлу 1919. године и састојала се од 375 денара и антонинијана у распону од Септимија Севера до Требонијана Гала и Волузијана (Табела 2). Оставу је првобитно обрадио и публиковао Јозо Петровић 1930. године, наводећи да је од 375 примерака, описао 339, јер је 36 комада пропало. Како је остава публикована према тадашњим стандардима и познатој литератури (Cohen), сматрали смо да је неопходно урадити ревизију у складу са новом референтном литературом.

Остава из Глибовца састоји се од 36 денара (10,62%) и 303 антонинијана (89,38%) и припада хоризонту остава похрањених у време Требонијана Гала и Волузијана, највероватније у првој половини 253. године (Табела 1). У остави је присутан новац 18 владара и чланова њихових породица у распону од 58 година (Табела 3). У највећем проценту заступљене су емисије Гордијана III (26,84%), следе ковања за Филипа I (23,30%) и Трајана Деција (20,05%). Најмлађе емисије Требонијана Гала и Волузијана присутне су у изузетно великом проценту (17,69%), за разлику од уобичајених завршних емисија у оставама средине 3. века. Када је у питању заступљеност ковница, на првом месту је ковница Рим са 93,10%, следи Виминацијум са високих 19,59%, док је ковница Милано присутна само са једним примерком. Источне ковнице заступљене су са 6,90%, од чега највећи део припада ковници Антиохија (5,93%), а ковница Емеса присутна је само са јединим примерком (Табела 5).

Најмлађи и једини примерак треће емисије римске ковнице у остави Глибовац је антонинијан Волузијана (кат. 326) датован у 252. годину (IMP C C VIB VOLVSIANVS AVG / PIETAS AVGG; RIC IV/3, no. 182). Сви остали примерци Требонијана Гала и Волузијана из римске ковнице потичу из 2а или 2б емисије с краја 251. године. С друге стране суочени смо с проблемом да се емисије из ковница Виминацијум и Антиохија не могу датовати прецизније и да једино можемо рећи да су емисије виминацијумске ковнице 251-253. године са знатним процентом учествовале у налазу из Глибовца (емисија 1 са 31 комадом и емисија 2 са 11 комада). Ковница Антиохија присутна је са два антонинијана кована за Требонијана Гала (Табела 15). На основу свега изнетог, сматрамо да *terminus post quem* оставе Глибовац треба тражити у првој половини 253. године, односно непосредно пре узурпације Емилијана крајем јуна исте године.
